## Important Note for Parents/Guardians

The SURVIVAL Program occurs in a relatively remote and challenging environment. Obviously, staff and volunteers are on duty around the clock. However, for an extended period of days, students are removed from the close-at-hand parental support that is usually available during school and home hours. Because of this, it has become extremely important that the students who are considered for this expedition be in excellent health, completely trustworthy, reliable, and emotionally stable. To ensure this, the criteria for student participation is more demanding than are normally the case for school related activities.

We earnestly seek parental understanding and support, as we are obliged to make these difficult decisions when considering your child for participation in the program.

Q: How do I qualify for Survival?

A: Seventh grade candidates voluntarily agree to undergo the consideration process used by the Advisory Board and published in the ORRJHS Handbook. Q: How much does it cost?

A: The program fee is \$65.00.

\*NOTE: Families should expect to spend at least \$350.00 for required equipment and/or rentals in addition to the program fee.

\*NOTE: The Survival program date will be adjusted according to the school year end date. Final date will be determined later in the year. (For 2022=APRIL 1)

Q: Are there buildings, bathrooms, and plumbing?

A: No! We use primitive latrines and use temporary plastic sheeting shelters.

Q: Can I leave early or come late to Survival?

A: NO, this is a full week program that begins at the JHS and ends at the JHS!

O: How much will I eat?

A: Minimal food for two days and plenty of food for the other days. You will pack some food and the rest is provided.

Q: What about stormy weather?

A: Ponchos! We are always outside and even temporary shelter is not always available.

Q: Will I be with my friends?

A: Probably not.

Q: Is there any equipment to borrow?

A: Yes, the program lends some a few pairs of boots and a few sleeping bags.






# Grade 7 Survival Program *Online* Application Form: Final Steps
